The successful candidate undertakes research and teaching in the field of Economics of the Near and Middle East with a sound development economics focus and an orientation in either economics or business administration. She/He will be part of CNMS, while being affiliated with the Faculty of Business Administration and Economics. The appointed junior professor has to offer two courses per semester at the Bachelor's and Master's level in English. Applicants should have Arabic and German language skills or at least show willingness to learn these languages. She/He will also contribute to the general research activities at the Faculty and at CNMS and procurement of external funding.

The conditions of employment are set down in § 64 Hessen State Law on Higher Education (HHG). Tenure track is intended according to the conditions described in § 61 (6) HHG. Philipps-Universität Marburg places great importance on the intensive mentoring of students and doctoral candidates; therefore, the regular presence of the teaching staff is required.
